I'll be honest and say I have no idea where the extra lyrics in other versions have come from. They certainly don't appear in Louis Prima's original in the Disney cartoon, so I haven't included them here.

Strum the first string of the chord with your thumb (eg- for Am you would strum the first string), and then strum the rest of the strings in that chord with your fingers. This will get you the most authentic sound. The isn't a guitar song, so the strumming pattern is very subjective and should be up to your own. There's also no good/easy way to put a pattern for a swing tempo, so be creative. Capo on 4 for the original key.
